



CLUB CAPTAINS / VICE CLUB CAPTAINS CRITERIA

CLUB CAPTAINS - MALE & FEMALE

The club captains should:

- Be positive role models for all swimmers
- Must be a financial member of the Club
- Make themselves known to all swimmers and be approachable, particularly for the younger members
- Be good ambassadors for the club
- Promote team morale and encourage all swimmers to achieve their best
- Always represent and promote the club in a positive manner
- Be willing to contribute towards the preparation of content for a Club newsletter and assist with social media
- Be willing to assist with the planning and organisation of social activities
- Club Captains are leaders that need to be over the age of 15 years.

The club captains will, from time to time, be asked to:

- Assist at club functions and events
- Attend events to represent the club
- Attend committee meetings to discuss issues concerning the swimmers, either at the request of the swimmers or the committee
- Make representations to the coaches and committee on behalf of the swimmers

Captaincy appointment will be for a period of 1 year. These are nominated to the committee and voted by the swimmers at the AGM

VICE CLUB CAPTAINS - MALE & FEMALE

The vice club captains should:

- Be positive role models for all junior swimmers
- Must be a financial member of the Club
- Make themselves known to all swimmers and be approachable, particularly for the younger members
- Be good ambassadors for the club
- Promote team morale and encourage all swimmers to achieve their best
- Always represent and promote the club in a positive manner
- Vice Club Captains are leaders that need to be 14 or under years of age.
- Assist the club captains

The Vice club captains will, from time to time, be asked to:

- Assist at club functions and events
- Attend events to represent the club

Vice Captaincy appointment will be for a period of 1 year. These are nominated to the committee and voted by the swimmers at the AGM.
